The 'Learning in Local Government Project' is an exploratory review of the unique and complex needs of education and professional development in Australian local government, and it aims to inform and facilitate programs to be developed over the life of the Australian Centre for Excellence in Local Government (ACELG). The attached paper has been designed as a platform for scoping issues, promoting discussion, debate and participation across the Australian local government sector.

Local government associations and training providers are also invited to review the inventory of training programs, discuss training delivery challenges in the local government sector, comment on identified training gaps, and discuss medium-term opportunities for the development of new programs.
