
IPWEA Leadership Series

At this breakfast, our two leaders are going to share some of their tips on the challenges of leading organisations in a growth environment with huge demands on infrastructure.



Kerry Thompson is the Chief Executive Officer of the Wyndham City Council. She has worked across a number of local government organizations including a 7 year term as Chief Executive Officer with the City of Maribynong.

In March 2009, Ms Thompson was seconded to advise the Victorian Bushfire Reconstruction and Recovery Authority (VBRRA) following the Black Saturday Bushfires, at the request of the VBRRA and the Municipal Association of Victoria. Ms Thompson is the current chair and founding member of the Western Transport Alliance and board member of LeadWest Ltd and the Institute of Public Administration. She is also a member of the Community Support Fund Advisory Committee and Victorian Drug and Alcohol Prevention Council, both by Ministerial appointment.



Rob Skinner was appointed Managing Director of Melbourne Water in February 2005 and is currently a board member of the Water Services Association of Australia. He is actively involved in a number of innovative sustainability initiatives in Melbourne and has been a leading figure in Victoria's water sensitive urban development programs. Prior to joining Melbourne Water, he was Chief Executive Officer of Kingston City Council for ten years. Other senior appointments prior to 1995 include General Manager Water Services with Melbourne Water, Chief Executive Officer of Dandenong Valley and Western Port Authority, Manager of Parliament and Government in the Department of Premier and Cabinet and Chief Executive of the Coode Island Review Panel.
