- list the required properties of aggregate for sprayed work
- recognise the required standard of preparation of surfaces for initial treatments and retreatments
- describe the purpose and function of priming, primersealing and sealing
- describe the correct procedures and practices for:
 - sweeping the pavement
 - loading and spraying bituminous materials
 - loading, precoating, spreading and rolling aggregate
 - protection of the work, structures
 - provision for traffic
 - monitoring performance of the work
- describe the main items of plant used and understand their operational functions
- understand the principles and perform the necessary calculations to determine the actual field rates of application of bituminous materials and aggregate
- recognise potential difficulties/problems that may be caused by weather or traffic conditions, and how to deal with them.
