

Sports Ground Maintenance

- 9 Full time qualified staff
- Maintenance of 65 Sports fields including turf athletics and turf croquet.
- 14 turf wicket tables
- 50 irrigation systems.





Sports Ground Challenges

- Access to sports fields for renovation works.
- Decreasing windows between seasons – summer to winter.
- Increasing usage of sports fields and impact on turf.





Golf Course Maintenance

- 6 Full time qualified staff & 1ST
 Year Apprentice.
- Glen Waverley Public Golf Course -18 holes & Practice facilities.
- Oakleigh Public Golf Course –
 9 Holes





Golf Course Challenges

- Irrigation water quantity
- Upgrade of irrigation system to use water efficiently.
- Upgrade of playing surfaces to meet current standards





Arterial Roads Vegetation Maintenance

- Contracted Service to Insight Horticultural Management.
- Grass mowing, garden beds, rubbish and tree debris clean up, weed spraying and nature strip maintenance.





Arterial Roads Challenges

- Dumped rubbish
- Safety
- Maintaining healthy landscapes
- Renewal gap





Park Maintenance Operational Overview

- Mowing and gardening completed at 560 sites across City of Monash.
- 3 New Holland tractors with Howard mowing and Gyrol edging attachments.
- Mowing Crews of 2 field staff with truck and trailer at 2-6 week intervals.
- Weed control program completed by 2 spray vehicles at 10 week intervals.


